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Summary

Opened: L18013 opened for material below L9300 at a point where we felt the exposure of L9300 had not contaminated the material below L9300 which L9300 seals.

Limits (N) W9262, L9168
 (S) L9559
 (E) L9878
 (W) W9140

Closed: L18013 closed when fragments of F18012, almost directly below L9300 were found.

Matrix: Brown loamy dirt with kurkaur pebbles.

Relations: L18013 is covered and sealed by pavement L9300.
 To the North, L18013 reaches W9262 and is cut by L9168.
 To the South, L18013 reaches L9559, L18013 is fill to F18012, L9559 is fill to F9559. Both L18013 and L9559 are at similar elevations and are probably part of the same fill to the same floor. However, this fragment of F9559 = F18012 does not survive past the south central area of L18013.
 To the east, L18013 reaches L9878. Both L18013 and L9878 are fills to their respective floors, the floor under L18013 being L18012 which is the same as F9878.
 To the west L18013 reaches W9140.
 L18013 covers but does not seal F18012 below.

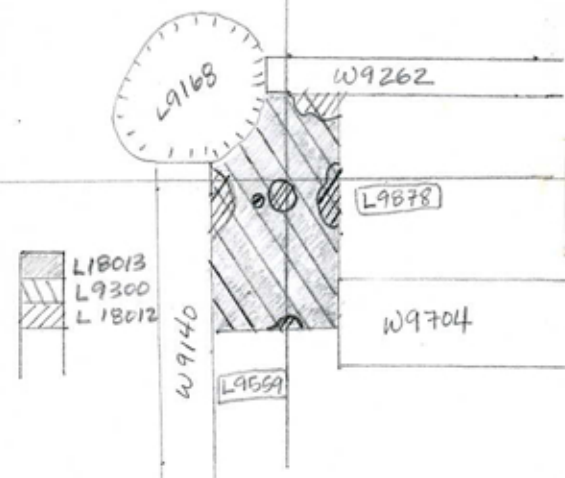
Additional Observations/Value: L18013 has medium value due to its possibly disturbed state as a result of the exposure of L9300 which seals L18013.
