Summary

Opened: when L18021 came down on floor in South half of Locus which did not extend to North half of L18021. L18032 opened in North half of Locus to account for possible extension of F18021 to N.

Limits (N) Bounded by W9211 to the North

(S) Bounded by L18067 and pit L9251 to the South.

(E) Bounded by W9275 to the East.

(W) Bounded by W9140 to the West.

Closed: Came down on floor/possible fallen reed matting in western two-thirds of Locus.

Matrix: Sandy orange brown mudbrick material with karkar bits, pottery, some bone and shell.

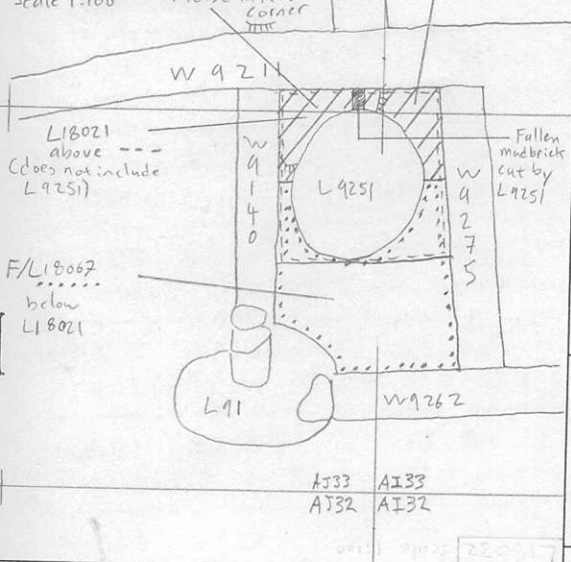
Relations: L18021 ^{but does not seal} covers L18032, which is the continuation of the matrix of L18021. L18032 reaches W9140 to the West, W9211 to the North, and W9275 to the East. To the South L18032 is cut by pit L9251. L18032 is the continuation of the matrix of L18067 to the South, although F18021, whose make-up belongs to the matrix of L18067 below, was not observed to extend northwards into L18032, nor was F18067, whose level is comparable to the level of L18032. Although the levels of Floors F18032 and F18067 are comparable, they do not represent the same floor, being of different matrices. F18032 is a reed mat surface which rises steeply to reach walls W9140 and W9211. F18067 is relatively level with a waxy grey surface covered with fish remains. F18032, which is also cut by pit L9251, may be fallen wall or ceiling material. The make-up of F18032 does not reach or continue into L18067. W9275 begins to float to the East of L18032 at 13.04, above the low for L18032 to the East.
