Opened: CAME DOWN ON DESTRUCTION WHILE EXCAVATING L18009, L18020, L18020. THE NORTHERN PART OF W9964 WAS REMOVED TO PROVIDE A LARGER EXPOSURE, WITH L18017, THESE LIMITS (N) AJ32, W9800 (S) BAULK UNDER W9963 AND W9964 AND L18025 (E) BAULK (W) BAULK UNDER DRAIN L9025 Closed: CAME DOWN ON F18033 ACROSS ENTIRE AREA. COLLAPSED WITH L18064 INTO L18078 Matrix: A MIX OF ORANGES, REDS, BLACK, AND GREY/WHITE DESTRUCTION MATERIAL. AND VERY LOOSE. DIFFERS FROM MUDBRICK FILL IN L18009, L18020, AND L18025 ABOVE. SAME AS L18017 ABOVE. SIMILAR, YET MORE VIVID THAN THE DESTRUCTION UNDER L18071 AND L18025 → THE SOUTH Relations: W9964 SEALS A PORTION OF L18033. L9991 CONTINUES DOWN AS L18033 LEVELING DEBRIS L18009, L18020, AND L18025 COVER BUT DO NOT SEAL L18033. L18017 UNDER L18009 CONTINUES DOWN INTO L18053. A "LUMP" OF BURNT MUDBRICK UNDER L18009 WAS LEFT UNEXCAVATED AS L18047 UNTIL F18033 WAS REACHED. F18047, THE ROOF OF THE DESTROYED BUILDING WAS NOTICED IN THE WEST BAULK AND EXTENDED INTO THE "LUMP." SINCE F18047 WAS NOT NOTICED IN L18053, MATERIAL ABOVE AND BELOW ROOF F18047 WERE EXCAVATED AS ONE UNIT. THUS L18033 CONTINUES INTO L18047 ABOVE F18047, AND INTO L18064 BELOW F18047. L18047 AND L18064 ARE THEREFORE IMPORTANT IN UNDERSTANDING THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN MATERIAL ABOVE AND BELOW ROOF F18047. L18033 CONTINUES NORTH INTO AJ32 OVER THE THRESHOLD OF W900 AS L9745 AND L9812 below. L18033 ALSO REACHES W9800 TO THE NORTH. L18033 CONTINUES INTO THE WEST BAULK UNDER DRAIN L9075, THE EAST BAULK, AND SOUTH UNDER W9963, W9964, AND L18025. L18033 COMES DOWN ON F18053 UPON WHICH WERE FOUND MULTIPLE SMASHED POTS, MOSTLY LARGE SARS, CONCENTRATED IN THE SW PART. OF L18033. F18033 REACHES W9800A. L18033 SEALS L18078 BELOW. ADDITIONAL PHOTOS: 117753-117755. JRZ suggests that this is a sealed deposit as there were no clear intrusions into it.
