Opened: LEFT POSSIBLE INSTALLATION ALONE WHILE EXCAVATING L18033. AFTER CEILING

F18047 WAS NOTICED UNDER THE "LUMP" AND F18033 WAS REACHED, MATERIAL ABOVE F18047 WAS

EXCAVATED AS L18047.

(W) BAULK UNDER DRAIN L9025

Closed: CLEARED DESTRUCTION DOWN TO CEILING F18047. CEILING MATRIX AND DESTRUCTION BELOW DOWN TO F18033 WAS THEN EXCAVATED AS L18064.

Matrix: ONE LARGE BURNT BRICK ON ITS SIDE AND OTHER BURNT BRICK DEBRIS WITH VIVIDLY COLORED DESTRUCTION SOIL. RED DESTRUCTION SOIL WAS NORTH OF THE BRICK, AND BLACK DESTRUCTION WAS SOUTH OF IT. SAME SOIL AS L18033 ABOVE AND AROUND, AND L18064 BELOW.

Relations: SINCE L18047 WAS LEFT UNTIL L18033 HAD BEEN BROUGHT DOWN TO DESTRUCTION F18033 LEVEL, WE ARE LEFT WITH THE UNUSUAL CASE IN WHICH THE DESTRUCTION MATERIAL OF L18033 WHICH WAS TREATED AS ONE UNIT CONTINUES INTO L18047 FROM ABOVE, NORTH, EAST, AND SOUTH. FURTHERMORE DESTRUCTION L18033 CONTINUES UNDER THE CEILING F18047 AS THE SAME MATERIAL, THUS THE SEPARATION BETWEEN MATERIAL ABOVE F18047 IN L18047, AND SEALED MATERIAL BELOW IN L18064 IS IMPORTANT TO UNDERSTANDING THE DIFFERENCE IN DESTRUCTION ABOVE CEILING F18047 AND BELOW THE CEILING IN L18064. L18047 CONTINUES INTO THE WEST BAULK UNDER DRAIN L9025. IT IS IMPORTANT TO NOTE THAT MUCH OF F18047 WAS NOTICED IN THE WESTERN BAULK. IT IS THUS MOSTLY A PHANTOM FLOOR WHICH IS ONLY INTACT IN A SMALL AREA ^{above} L18064.

The matrix of the ceiling is described under L18064 since L18064 is ceiling makeup and fill to floor.

* though numbered separately as L18064.

Note that beam fragments, burnt matting and ceiling mud material were excavated in L18033 but not recognized as such until it became visible in section. F18047 may have originally covered all of L18033.

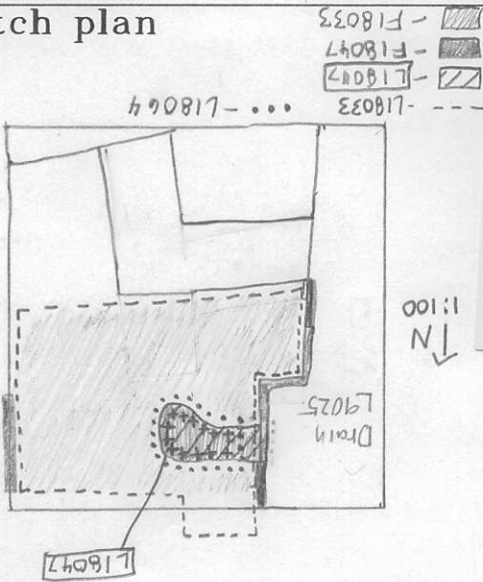
