POWDERY BRIGHT REDS, ORANGES, AND WHITES WITH A SMATTERING OF FISTSIZED CLODS OF BURNT MUDBRICK. THIS LOCUS PRODUCED HALF AN INCH DEEP GRINDING VESSEL AND SOME IN SITU VESSELS ON THE FLOOR. IRON AGE, BEYOND THINKING OF A DOUBT.

Relations: L18072 WAS COVERED BUT NOT SEALED BY L18069 ABOVE. HOWEVER, L18069 IS SEALED BY A FLOOR, F/L18038 WHICH SEALS ALL DESTRUCTION DEBRIS BELOW.

TO THE NORTH, F/L18072 CONTINUES INTO L18058.

TO THE SOUTH, F/L18072 REACHES BIN L18073, CONTINUES INTO 9779 AND 9832 EXCAVATED 1193.

TO THE EAST, F/L18072 REACHES (OR SUSPECTS) L9982.

TO THE WEST, F/L18072 CONTINUES INTO L18058.

WENT BELOW F18072 INTO EARLIER MATERIAL (BUT NOT BY MUCH.) NO FINDS KEPT.

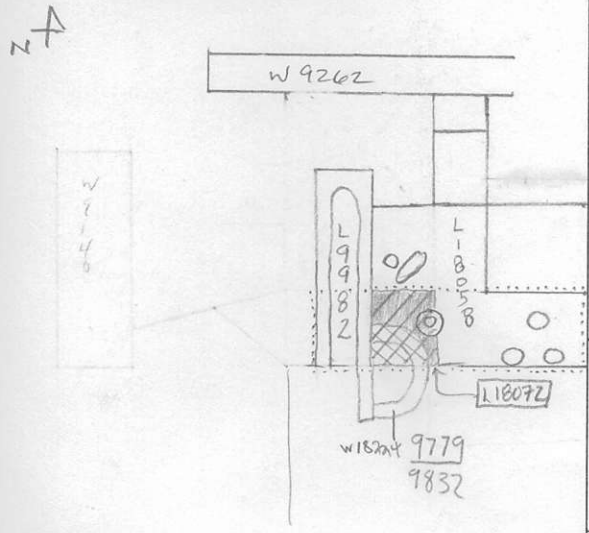

Closed: IN A CRAZY MISTAKE OF EXCAVATION, WENT BELOW F18072, INTO MATERIAL BELOW, STOPPED - END OF SEASON.				
Matrix: Destruction matrix as these mainly, mainly destruction loci around powdery bright reds, oranges, and whites with a smattering of fist-sized clods of burnt mudbrick. this locus produced half an entire basket grinding vessel and some in situ vessels on the floor. IRON AGE, beyond thinking of a doubt?				
Relations: L18072 was covered but not sealed by L18069 above. However, L18069 is sealed by a floor, F/L18038 which seals all destruction debris below it.				
To the north, F/L18072 continues into L18058.				
To the south, F/L18072 reaches bin L18073, continues into 9779 and 9832 excavated in 93				
To the east, F/L18072 reaches (one suspects) L9982.				
To the west, F/L18072 continues into L18058.				
Went below F18072 into earlier material (but not by much.) No finds kept				
CLOSED @ end of season				

Additional Observations/Value: Low Value other than reaching the bin. L18073. As it is a disturbed locus.
