Closed: floor patches^{of F18076=F9986} were discovered. End of season.

Matrix: reddish brown soil throughout, small deposits of grey soil and a hardening of the soil towards L18045. A Kurkar floor was apparent when the locus was closed

Relations: L9986 covers [L18081]. L18081 is a south and downward sloping continuation of [L9986]

** To the North [L18081] slopes up and continues into [L9986]

To the South [L18081] continues into the debris beneath W9278

To the East [L18081] reaches 18045

To the West [L18081] slopes up and continues into [L9986] and seems to reach W9989 *

[L18081] is patchy; it covers but does not seal whatever locus is opened below.

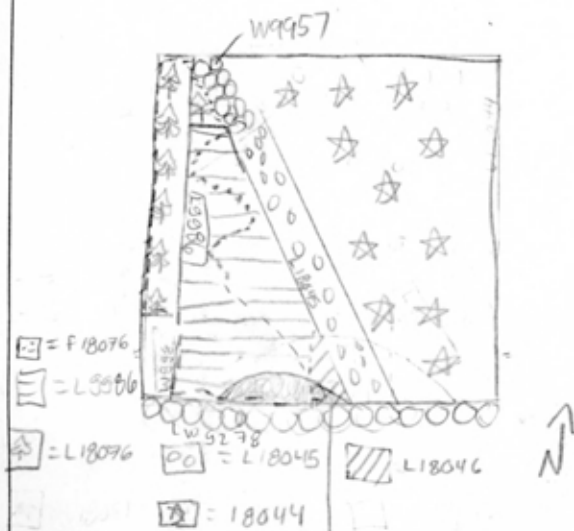
[L18081] was opened to search for a floor which was emerging in L18076. A floor was reached and could be traced north and east and west past the perimeters of [L18081]. It continues into the debris beneath W9560. This floor material is at the same elevation as that of L18076 and should be more fully excavated next season

** [L18081] is a downward sloping continuation of [L9986] and so 9986 is both above and to the side of [L18081].
