- Limits (N) debris below stone part of W18010
 (S) debris below W9211 and stones of possible wall
 (E) debris below stone part of W9408
 (W) debris below W9510

Closed: End of Season, not closed. Floor beginning to appear

Matrix: F18041 was thin, grey, charred speckled. Sandy soil

Relations: F18088 is covered by 18041 and 18085. It is sealed by F18041.
 To the north F18088 seems to continue in debris below stone part of W18010
 To the south F18088 continues in debris below W9211; relation to possible stone wall is uncertain.
 To the east F18088 seems to continue in debris below stone part of W9408
 To the west F18088 continues in debris below W9510.

Floor relations of F18088 are unclear due to incomplete excavation

Note that W18010 and W9408 seem to begin to float in F18088 just below F18041

Additional Observations/Value: Sealed deposit, containing what to plan looked like LB pottery. Potentially very important.

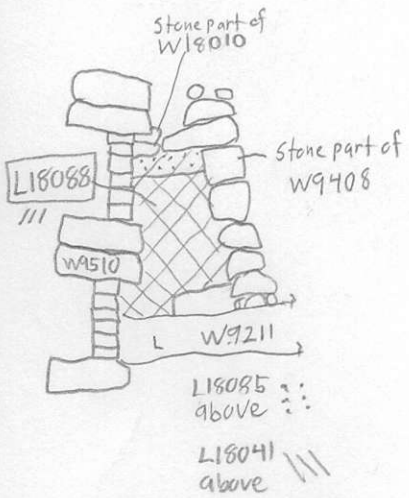
