Relations: Loci ABOVE: L18203 WAS COVERED BY L9428 ALTHOUGH L18203 MAY HAVE CUT L9428. THIS WAS NOT DETERMINED IN THE 1988 EXCAVATION SEASON. F9428 WAS CUT BY N: L18203 REACHES W18226. E: L18203 REACHES W9515. S&W: L18203 CUTS F9428, L18204, L18211 AND L18222. Loci BELOW: L18203 COVERS L18238.

L18203 must have robbed some feature, certainly not concrete F9428. Perhaps there was a small wall or installation in the NE corner of this room

* Apparently L18203 came down onto floor 18222, as L18222 and L18203 subsequently collapsed into fill & fill below locus = L18238

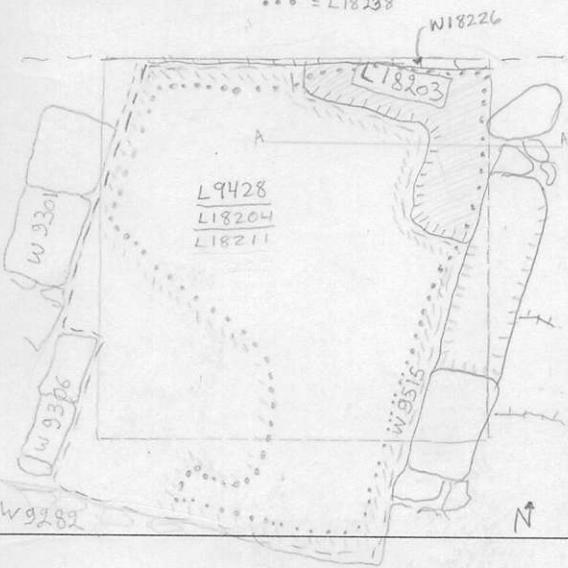

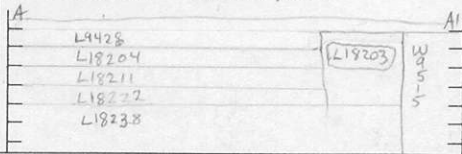
