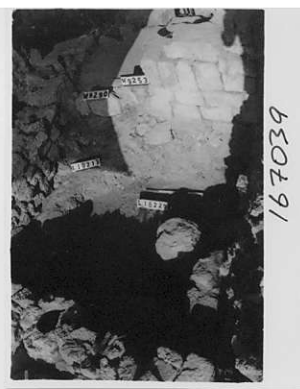

Persian pottery in mudbrick loci L18213 and L18268 are certainly contamination from pit [L18225]

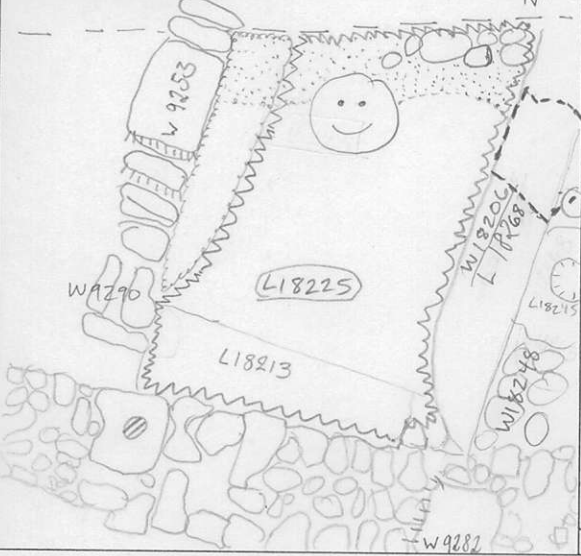
