Opened: WAS A HIGHER AREA USED AS A BANK WHILE EXCAVATING L18222, W18223 AND L18238. ATTEMPTED TO FIND FLOOR CONTINUING FROM L18222 AND/OR L18238.

Closed: CAME TO A ROCK THAT APPEARED IN THE EAST THAT COULD HAVE BEEN PART OF W18223. ALSO MORE STONES WERE IN L18258 BELOW ALONG WITH A REDDISH BROWN SOIL CHANGE.

Matrix: GREY BROWN ASHY SOIL WITH A FEW FIST SIZE ROCKS.

Relations: LOCUS ABOVE: L18255 IS SEALED BY L18211, THE SEALED LOCUS BELOW L18204.

N: L18255 WAS PROBABLY CUT BY W18223 AND L18274 BECAUSE THE MUDBRICK MATERIAL FOUNDATION OF L18274 DID NOT EXTEND INTO L18255 AND L18274 MAY BE FOUNDATION MATERIAL FOR W18223

W: L18255 IS CUT BY W18248 AND L18245 BECAUSE THEY SEEM TO BE A FOUNDATION AT THIS ELEVATION. A LARGE ROCK, 40CM WIDE, JUTS INTO L18255 FROM W18248.

S: L18255 IS PROBABLY CUT BY W9282(b) AS L18255 IS IRON AGE AND W9282(b) IS LATER, MAYBE PERSIAN, BUT MAINLY BECAUSE W9282 seems to be a foundation at this elevation.

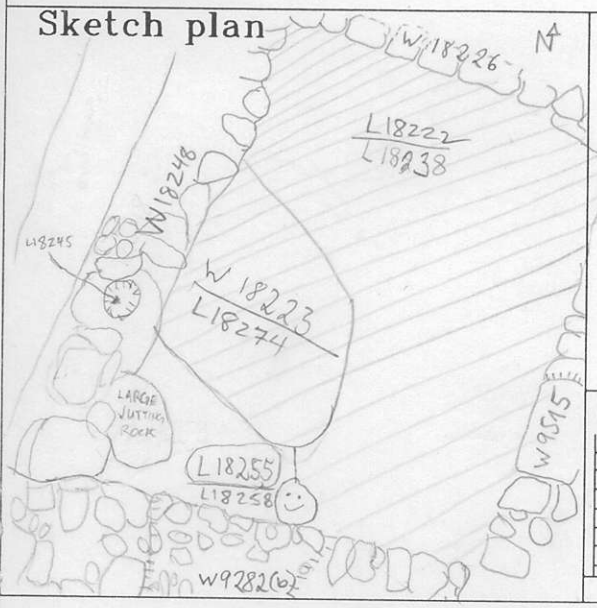
E: THE RELATIONSHIPS BETWEEN L18222, L18238, L18255, L18258, L18287 AND L18288 ARE UNCERTAIN. THIS IS DUE TO THE SMALL SIZE OF L18255 AND L18258 WHICH ARE PROBABLY CUT BY W9282, W18223 AND W18248, WHICH SEEM TO BE FOUNDATIONS AT THIS ELEVATION. HOWEVER, BASED ON ELEVATIONS, L18222 PROBABLY CONTINUES INTO L18255 AT 14.73M-14.77M AND L18258 AT 14.64M; AND L18238 PROBABLY CONTINUES INTO L18258 ABOVE F18222 ALSO AT 14.64M. IT IS LIKELY THAT F18222 AT 14.77M-14.69M IS A RESURFACING OF F18238 AT 14.66M. F18222 AND F18238 ARE PROBABLY CONTINUED IN L18258 AS F18258 AT 14.64M. L18287 WOULD BE FLOOR MAKEUP OF F18222 AND F18238 AND THE SAME AS THE FLOOR MAKEUP OF F18258 AND F18288. F18258 ONLY APPEARS NEXT TO W9282(b), NOT UNDER THE JUTTING ROCK OF W18248 OR L18274.

LOCUS BELOW: L18255 COVERS BUT DOES NOT SEAL L18258.
