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Summary

Opened: While excavating L18256, came down on a floor and a possible pit. The floor area became L18264 and the pit became L18263.

Limits (N) Temporary bank  
 (S) bank under W9262  
 (E) L18263  
 (W) W9140

Closed: Came down on F18263/64, collapsed into L1827A.

Matrix: F18256 is white army grey material. Material below is reddish mudbrick material and hard packed debris.

Relations: Above: L18256 covers but does not seal L18264.  
 North: L18264 continues into a temporary bank.  
 South: L18264 continues under W9262.  
 East: L18264 is cut by pit L18263.  
 West: L18264 reaches W9140 but does not seal.  
 Below: L18264 comes down on F18264, and covers L1827A.

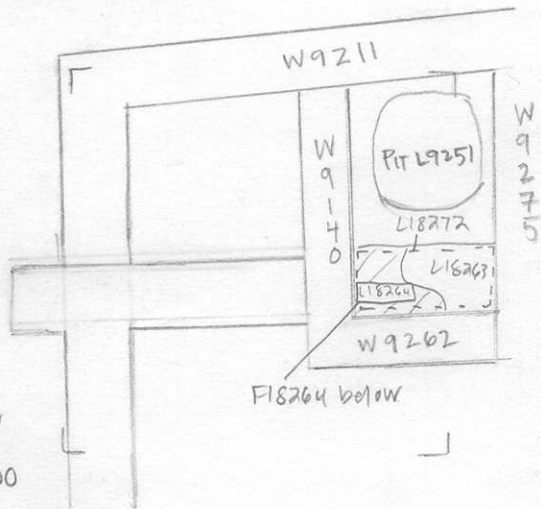
F18264 continues under W9262 and reaches W9140, and continues under the west face of W9275. F18264 = F18292 = F18289 where it may have reached the lowest stone course of W9275, which on the east continues down 3 more courses than on the west.

Note: In the photographs, F18264 was labeled F18263. The actual number is in fact F18264.
