Matrix: Medium grey brown sandy soil with lots of mudbrick debris and clay.

Relations: Above: L18276 continues down into L18291 (most likely) and does not seal it.

North: L18291 continues into L18290, and reaches the high east face of W18275.

South: L18291 continues into L18302.

East & west: L18291 continues into the balks

Below: L18291 comes down on the lower part of the west face of W18275, and comes down on W18296, and continues into L18297 and L18295 and does not seal them

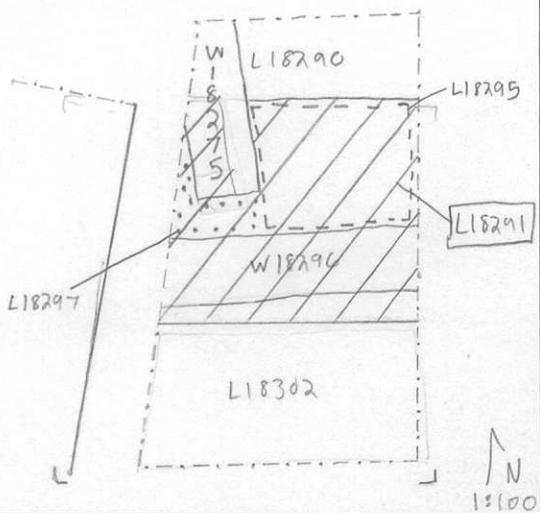
