Relations: Above: L18239 comes down on L18294
North, South, East and West: F18239 reaches the stones of L18294.
Until we excavate below this floor then, there are no loci below it.

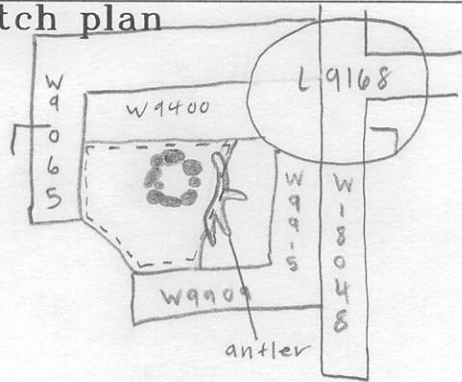
