East: L18302 continues into the Balk.

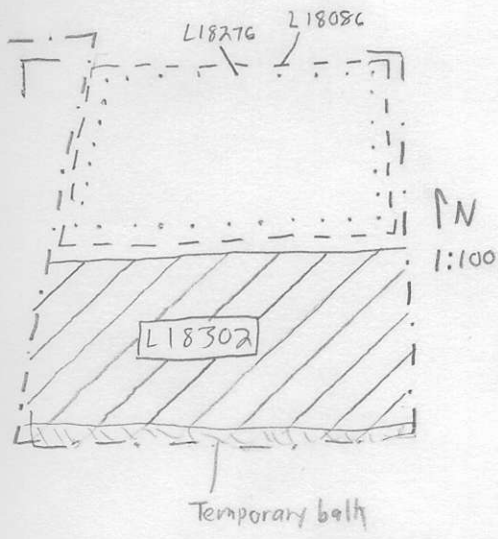
West: L18302 continues into the Balk.
