Summary

Opened: on last day of dig architect drawing a section thought he saw a wall previously unnoticed in the east balt. Uncertain if it is a wall, but locus opened to be sure

Limits (N) Balt

Closed: Not closed, end of season

Matrix: 1-1.5 courses of fieldstones all ca. 16 cm across. Possible, degraded mudbrick on south part of wall

Relations: Above: Balt. Part of roof of building seems to have fallen on this wall as a white line of roof material & rests on it

North: Balt

South: Balt

East: continues east into balt

West: Most likely reached by destruction locus 18058

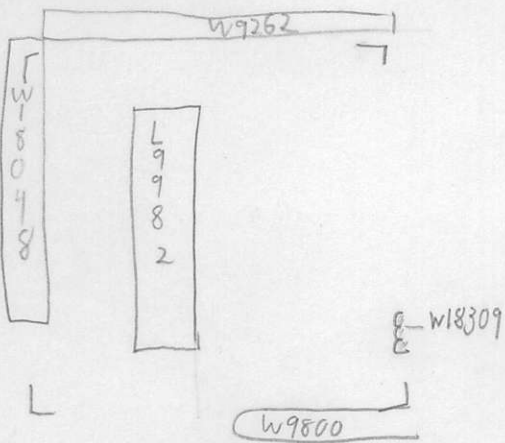
Below: (W18309) is built on top of F18058
