Opened: WHILE EXCAVATING L18273 WE CAME DOWN ON W18349

Closed: NOT CLOSED, END OF THE SEASON

Matrix: 2-3 COURSE HIGH WALL, LOWEST COURSE ARE HEADSIZE STONES WITH FISTSIZE STONES IN BETWEEN SECOND COURSE CONSISTS OF FISTSIZE STONES ON TOP. THE WALL WAS COVERED BY A LAYER OF LOOSE BROWN SOIL. There is a 70cm space in the southern upper course of W18349 which may be a doorway between W18349 + W18229. The 2nd + possibly 3 courses almost reach the stone scale below the middle stone pier of W18229.

Relations: ABOVE: W18349 IS SEALED BY THE MUDBRICKS OF L18273 ← 2/26/02 SEE NOTE ON THIS LOCUS CARD. L18273 IS MUDBRICK SUPERSTRUCTURE

BELOW: NO LOCI BELOW

TO THE NORTH: W18349 CONTINUES IN THE BALK UNDER W9262

TO THE SOUTH: W18349 HAS A POSSIBLE DOORWAY BETWEEN THE STONE PIER OF W18229 AND W18349

TO THE WEST: L18320+L18350 may be cut by W18349 as a possible FT. Was seen in the p L18273. CUTS THE WESTERN HALF OF THE POSSIBLE DOORWAY OF W18349.

TO THE EAST: F18313 REACHES W18349. L18313, continuing possibly into 18273, likely reaches W18349

* THIS GAP SEEMS NOT TO EXIST IN THE LOWER COURSES.

W18349 is a very poor wall. It is possible that L18273 represents some sort of mudbrick super structure for W18349 but it was difficult to identify many bricks. The stones on the top of W18349 are partly laid and look almost like a line of rubble. The gap between the south "face" of W18349 and the north face of the stone pier in W18229 may be a doorway. At this stage it can not be said that W18349 reach the lower stone scale of W18229. Because it was impossible to clearly define L18273, the rubbly appearance of W18349, debris assigned to L18273 covers W18349 and reaches it from S, E and W. Probably on the E a mix of 18273 and 18243+18313 reaches W18349; F18313 certainly does. On the W it may be that W/E 18286, again mixed with 18273, reached W18349. W18349 may begin to float just above the closing level of L18350; currently there is a 30cm gap in which JRZ could find no additional courses.

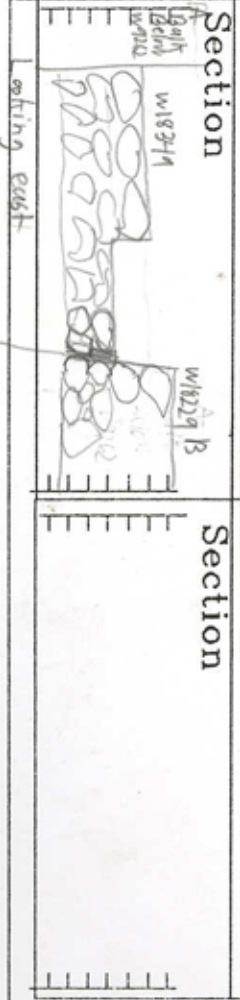

Opened: W18349 WAS FLOATING ON ITS EASTERN AND WESTERN SIDE AND WE DECIDED THEREFORE TO REMOVE THE WALL

Limits (N) RAIL UNDER W9962

Closed: WE REMOVED ALL COURSES OF W18349

Matrix: (SEE PREVIOUS CARDS) THE LOWER TWO COURSES WERE RATHER REGULAR LAYD FIELDSTONES TRYING TO CREATE AN FACING ON BOTH WALL SURFACES

Relations: ABOVE: SEE PREVIOUS CARDS

NORTH: DITO

SOUTH: BY REMOVING THE WALL IT BECAME CLEAR THAT W18349 REACHES W18229 BUT IS IN NO WAY OVERLAPPING WITH IT. W18349 IS THEREFORE BUILT AGAINST W18229. THE FACT THAT THEY BOTH HAVE THEIR LOWEST COURSE ON APPROXIMATELY THE SAME LEVEL SUGGESTS THAT THE TIME GAP BETWEEN BOTH THEIR CONSTRUCTION IS LIMITED.

EAST & WEST: SEE PREVIOUS CARDS. W18349 cuts L 18366 on the east.

BELOW: W18349 covers, but does not seal, L18373 which is also partially covered by unsealed Fill 118366

Additional Observations/Value: MEDIUM VALUE: Provides doorway between bene/crucible room and bellows pot room.
