Matrix: 1/4 OF THE CIRCULAR STRUCTURE WAS PRESERVED (±40CM HIGH) CONSISTING OF TYPICAL THICK TABUN SHELDS, MORE SHELDS NEAR ITS BASE. THE INSIDE WAS FILLED WITH GREY-TO DARK BROWN SOIL COMING DOWN ON A THIN LAYER OF WHITE ASHY MATERIAL MIXED WITH CHARCOAL FRAGMENTS

Sketch plan



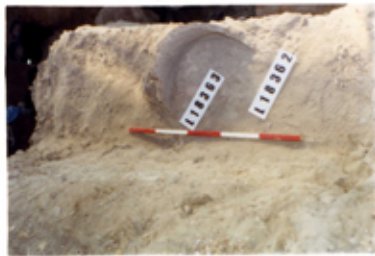
