Opened: START OF SEASON. WE WANTED TO EXCAVATE THE WHOLE "ROOM" BETWEEN W9140 AND W9275 and the locus area was divided in NORTH, CENTER OR SOUTH to separate pottery in case of intrusions

Limits (N) W9211  
 (S) BALK  
 (E) BALK UNDER W9275  
 (W) W9915 (formerly the wall known as W9140)

Closed: we (FINALLY) CAME DOWN ON F18369

Matrix: HOWEVER, BEING ONE LOCUS, L18369 WAS DIVIDED IN THREE. THE SOUTH CONTAINED GREY SOIL WITH SANDY PATCHES. THE CENTER WAS MORE REDDISH AND DELIVERED SOME IRX DARK BROWN MUDBRICKS. THE MATRIX IN THE NORTH THEN, WAS AGAIN GREY BUT WITHOUT SAND INCLUSIONS. ALL CAME DOWN ON A FRAGMENTARY FLOOR MADE OUT OF CRIMPED GREY-WHITE SOIL WITH IN THE SW A POSSIBLE VANSTEENHUYSE PIT (BRIGHT WHITE

Relations: ABOVE BROWN SOIL, 1183-1177

ABOVE: L18271, L18299, L18305, L9251 AND L18285 ALL COVER BUT DO NOT SEAL L18369

NORTH: F/L18369 CONTINUES INTO THE BALK UNDERNEATH W9211, W911 floats above F18369

SOUTH: L18369 PROBABLY CONTINUED INTO L18285. F18369 MIGHT HAVE ITS CONTINUATION IN F18286 (ACCORDING TO THE LEVELS) OR IN F18320 WHICH IS A BIT LOWER BUT REMAINS A CANDIDATE DUE TO THE GENERAL N-S SLOPE. [ F18286: 1189-1184 F18320: 1167 ]

EAST: F/L18369 CONTINUES INTO BALK UNDERNEATH W9275

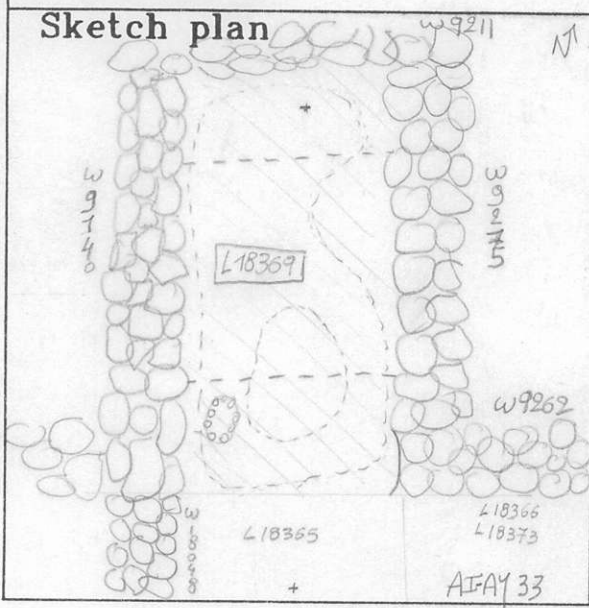
WEST: L18369 REACHES W9915 BUT F18369 IS PROBABLY CUT BY W9915, SINCE SIX A LINE WAS VISIBLE AND NO REACH COULD BE ESTABLISHED. Note also that the northern 1/4 of W9915 (where it makes a corner with W9211) floats above F18369. This likely makes F18369 local phase 4, so whichever floor +
