Matrix: THIS IS THE FLOOR MAKE UP OF F18370 ABOUT 10CM THICK CONSISTING OUT OF WHITE ASHY AND GREY SURFACES WITH BROWN-LIGHT ORANGE SOIL PATCHES AND SEVERAL MENDABLE SHERDS ON TOP OF THE SEVERAL SURFACES. IN THE SOUTH 1 STONE ($\pm \phi 50cm$) AND 5-6 fist size STONES FORM PART OF THE SURFACES

Relations: ABOVE: L18370 COVERS L18375 WHICH IS THE FLOOR MAKE UP OF F18370 *

NORTH: L18375 CONTINUES IN THE BALK UNDER W9400 BUT SLOPES UP QUITE STEEP TO THE EAST WHERE IT WANTS TO REACH W9915. BELOW THIS SLOPE IS SOME VERY LOOSE, RED AND STERILE SOIL VISIBLE WHICH IS COVERED BY L18375 AND LEANS AGAINST W9915

SOUTH: L18375 WAS NOT SEEN TO REACH W9909 due to the many small stones in that area. It seems likely that **

EAST: SEE NORTH, PLUS THE FLOOR ALSO SEEMS TO DIP DOWN IN THE CENTER TOWARDS L18306 WHICH MAKES IT UNCLEAR IF THE EASTERN EXTENSION OF L18375 WAS EVER COVERING L18306 OR EQUALLED IT. See extensive additional note on card for L18370.

WEST: L18375 CONTINUES IN THE BALK





BELOW: L18390 IS COVERED BUT NOT SEALED BY L18375
