Summary

Opened: L 18384 came down on a floor but F 18384 was already defined higher up, therefore, this locus (floor) received no L 18403

Limits (N) BALK  
 (S) W18229  
 (E) L 18365  
 (W) W 9915

Closed: L 18403 was opened and immediately closed since it is simply a technical locus in order to be able to discuss all floors in L 18384.

Matrix: F 18403 consists out of white soft plaster material and was thick enough to be easily traceable.

Relations: ABOVE: L 18384 covers but does not seal F 18403  
NORTH: F 18403 continues into the balk  
SOUTH: F 18403 did not extend through the area of L 18384 adjacent to W18229. The relationship is \*  
EAST: F 18403 continues into F 18365 which is an earlier resurfacing of F 18403 and likely continues also into F 18373. The connection is attested by a line visible in the north section above L 18365. This floorline was not excavated as a floor in L 18365 but missed, yet \*\*  
WEST: F 18403 does not reach stage C of W 9915 but seems rather to dive underneath the wall. This was confirmed when W 9915 was completely removed and F 18403 could be traced below the wall, into L 18400  
BELOW: F 18403 seals part of L 18418

\* thus a bit speculative. However, since F 18403 goes under W 9915, which is contemporary with W 18229, it is likely that F 18403 originally went below W 18229 as well.

\*\* it falls within the range of L 18365 and does <sup>not</sup> relate to any other floor

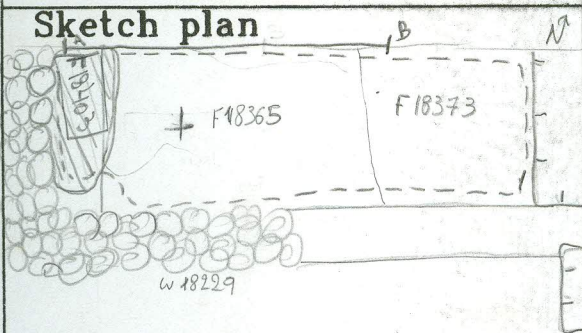

Sketch plan



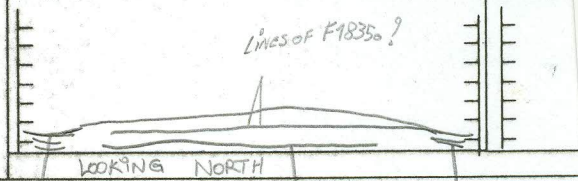
