**Opened:** L18439 removed exposing a single deposit over an extended area (= L18448).

**Limits (N)** Baulk under W9400.

(S) Subsidiary baulk - L18462

(E) L18393 and L18400 (both excavated 1999).

(W) Baulk under W9065.

**Closed:** Came down on shells of floor make-up (L18451) and preserved flooring (L18457) below.

**Matrix:** Compact reddish brown matrix, perhaps mudbrick detritus, covering shell floor insatllation and fallen stones.

**Relations:** This locus = L18393 (1999) = L18306 (1998? according to 1999 notes). In the 1999 excavation L18393 reached walls W9909 and W9915. In the N this matrix covers the stones of E-W wall W18463. To the S the matrix covers fallen stones and preserved flooring L18457.

L18448 = L18462 = L18466 = L18451 = L18393 (1999) =? L18306 (1999) = L18470. See drawing for L18462.

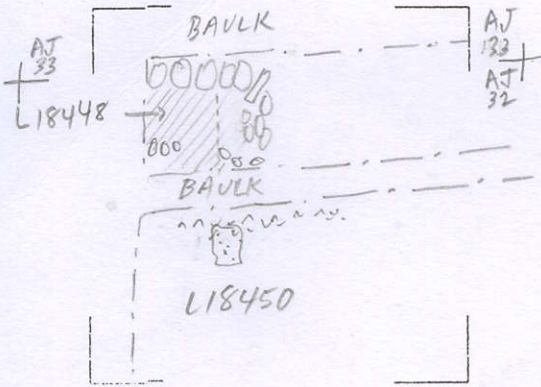
**Importance:** Medium value. Portion of more extensive matrix which seals F18470 below. Iron Ia pottery, although other loci = LB / Iron Ia.
