Opened: Grey patch (30cm x 20cm), possible preserved surface above shells below.

Limits (N))

(S) Baulk = L18459, top of L18462) patch 30cmx20cm

Closed: Limited extent of possible floor remnant with no significant surface remains.

Matrix: Grey matrix with charcoal above shell floor make-up.

Relations: This isolated patch was covered and surrounded by the compact reddish-brown matrix L18451 = L18462. The ash and charcoal is the only indicator that this may have been a surface. No corroborating evidence (e.g. flat lying sherds) was forthcoming. This was likely a charcoal and ash concentration within the fill / collapse L18451 = L18462 rather than preserved flooring.

Importance: No value - very limited extent with no significant finds. Uncertain context.

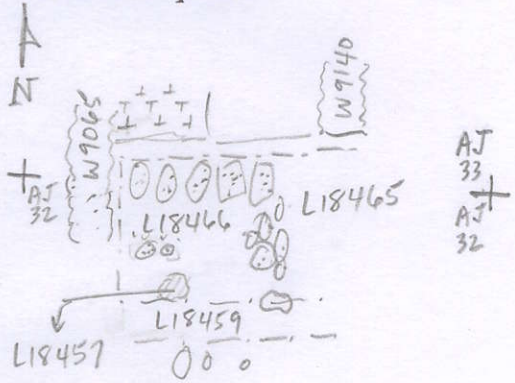
