summary:

Opened: Crucible / tabun bottom broken into pieces and separated by halves lying on surface

- Limits (N)** baulk
 (S) baulk
 (E) baulk
 (W) baulk

Closed: Surface finds removed - excavation proceeded through subsequent surfaces as L18496

Matrix: Thick ash deposits surrounding crucible/tabun bottom. Ash decreases with distance from the crucible/tabun bottom.

Relations: L18491 continues to the S, likely as L18483. The surfaces wax and wane so it is difficult to trace them down slope through baulks. This surface should have been designated fl.18480, but I goofed!

Four photographs (192658 - 1926661) were taken.

The tabun/crucible bottom was not in situ, but slid down the slope.

Importance: Potential high value - if analysis demonstrates crucible rather than tabun bottom. LB pottery.
