Closed: L18496 was closed when two distinct matrices appeared below, a compact brown matrix along the N and Eern edges of the area (L18454) with multiple surfaces (L18513) descending from it.

Matrix: Layers and lenses of brown dirt, ashy matrix with charcoal, sand and plaster.

Relations: A bronze platelet, perhaps a scale pan fragment, lay in this locus.


This locus descends dramatically to the W.
