 (1) to the north of W18045 a crushed kurkar fl. with a stone (fallen?) on it. this patch is very much like F18553 (lower and southward in the "same courtyard")  
 (2) a small patch of plaster floor (see sketch)

the kurkar floor (1) reaches W18045, and this is all we can say about its relations.

Additional Observations/Value: L18553 is fill to floor in the "courtyard" of the IA building
