

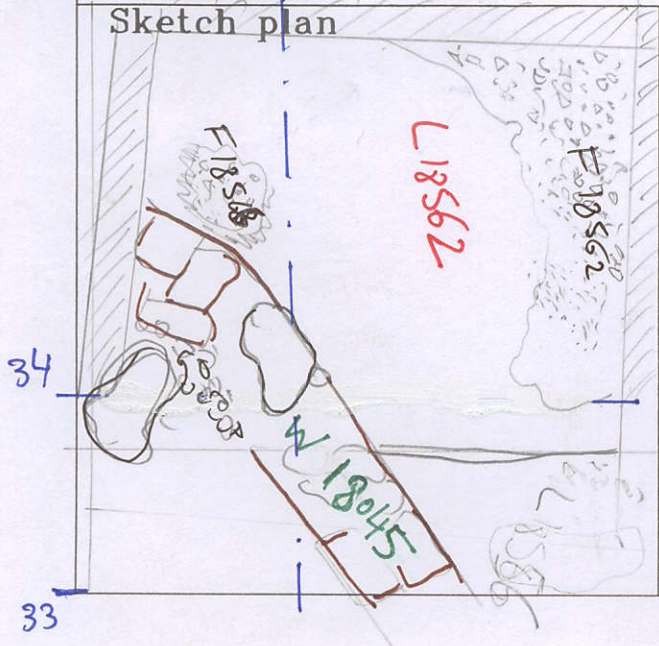

Opened: when patches of F18559 above were gently removed					
Limits (N) blk. (Area G North limit)					
(S) W18045, 18560					
(E) blk. below W9515					
(W) 18045 blk. AG-AH/34					
Closed: when F18562 was observed					
Matrix: soft grey soil with tiny stones					
Relations: L18562 is a fill in the courtyard of the IA building					
L18562 is ADJACENT to: Mudbrick walls (18045) and (18560).					
Digging L18562 we came down to 2 "floors": At the NE: <u>F18562</u>					
and at the west: <u>F18566</u> (see sketch)					
F18562: this is a fragmentary yellowish plaster floor with pebbles in it. F18562 has no observed relations.					
F18566: pressed fill with shallow a little plaster and small burn patches					
F18566 maybe reached W18045.					
(As I suspect these 2 are a part of the same thing)					
As soon as these floors were observed L18562 was closed					
Additional Observations/Value: L18562 is fill to floor(s) in the "Courtyard" of the IA building
