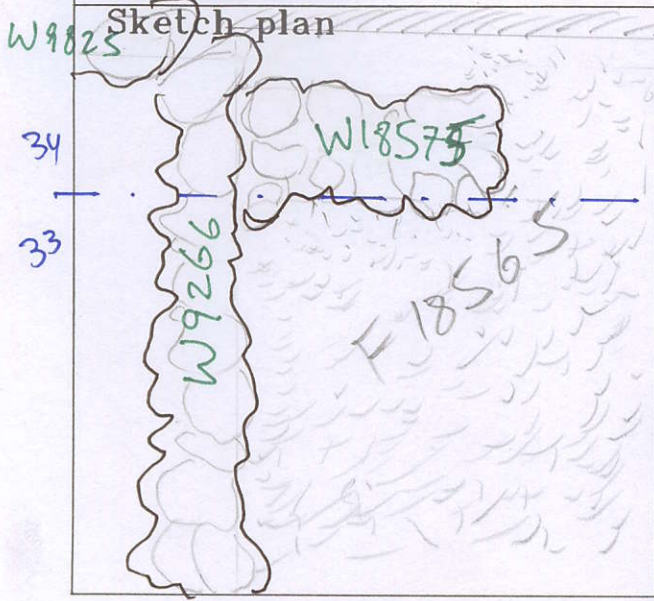
At the West it is adjacent (?) to W 9266.
