Opened: 2 large adjacent stones appeared with smaller stones below

Closed: not closed, end of season (loci below = not excavated)

Matrix: Fieldstone wall consisting of 2 courses. Stone widths range in size from approximately 11 cm to 45 cm. Contemporary with lower section of W9975. Bottom of wall not yet reached - end of season.

Relations: W18912 is bonded on the W to W9975 (J. Berg), however only one face is visible, the top and 2nd face are unexcavated and so the relationship is provisional. W18912 bonds to the 5-8th lower courses of W9975 (the bottom 4 courses currently exposed). L18904 reached W9975 and W18912, but F18904 was identified only in the southern part of the room in the corner opposite the junction of W9975 and W18912.

In 2004 we have reached to the lower stone level of this wall and we could see its southern face. The height of its bottom is 12.73.

Importance: Possible Phase 8 wall

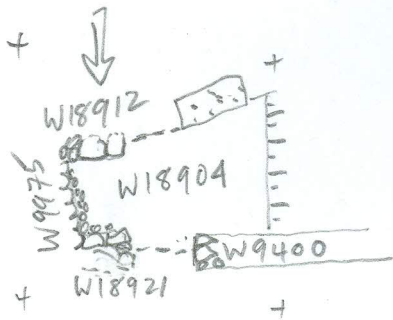
