

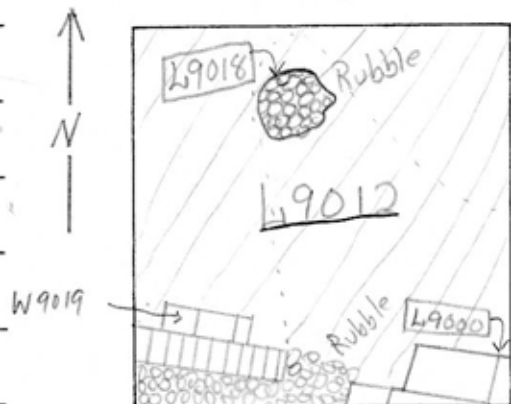

OPENED [L9012] was opened when one whole stone block and parts of others were found in the southeast corner of the square. These stones are a northern extension of [L9000] in AJ31.
DEFINITION/LIMITS The soil of [L9012] extended from the paving stones of [L9000] across the entire area of the square.
CLOSED - [L9012] was closed when a kurkar surface and a header wall with adjoining stones [W9019] were found.
RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS The soil of [L9012] covered the kurkar surface and [W9019] with its adjoining stones. The headers of [W9019] were at a slightly higher level than the adjoining stones. Kurkar floor [L9012] reached [W9019] and its adjoining stones at the level of the adjoining stones. Pavement [L9000] floated above Floor [L9012]. Floor [L9012] reached

* section of the west bulk it appears that floor [L9012] may have covered the top of [W9019]

from [W9019] northward to the north baulk, and from the west baulk to the east baulk. Floor [L9012] was cut in the northern part of the square by rocky rubble that was later recognized as a pit [L9018]. Floor [L9012] was also cut by rubble along the southern baulk.
MATRIX Soil in [L9012] was fine, brown, fairly loose, with scattered tesserae, broken roof tiles, and sherds. Some bits of marble and rocks up to 10cm in diameter were found.
