

[OPENED] L9033 was opened to excavate the kurkar floor material of L9027.

[DEFINITION/LIMITS] L9033 extended northward from L9019 along the west baulk for about 2½ meters. It extended eastward from the west baulk for about 2 meters.

[CLOSED] L9033 was closed as a technical change to incorporate the areas covered by L9032 and L9031 into a single locus, there being no apparent difference in the matrices.

[RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS] L9033 extended northward along the west baulk for about 2½ meters at a level

lower than the flat stones adjacent to L9019. L9033 reaches L9019. The stones adjacent to L9019 rested upon the floor make up of L9033. MATRIX Soil in L9033 was medium brown with some ash lenses. Many sherds and bones were found, but few diagnostic sherds. Heavy rubble with stones as large as 30 cm across was found extending northward from the east end of L9019. A bronze coin was found near this rubble, and another in a bucket of earth from this locus. Floor make up was packed kurkar about 8cm thick.
