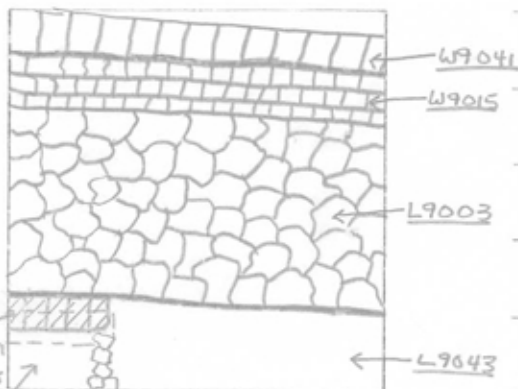

REASON FOR OPENING: UPON REMOVAL OF [W9009], A WALL OF DOUBLE HEADERS, ANOTHER EARLIER WALL CLEARLY NOT A PART OF L9003 WAS DEFINED.

DEFINITION/LIMITS: DEFINED BY [L9003] ON THE NORTH, AND THE WESTERN BANK. EXTENDS EASTWARD 1.7 METERS AND SOUTH THE WIDTH OF 1 COURSE. CONSTRUCTION IS OF KURKAR BLOCKS 40 x 30 x 30 x CM

REASON FOR CLOSING: END OF '86 SEASON, NOT CLOSED

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: [W9009] RESTED UPON THE SOUTHERN THIRD OF [W9040]. DURING CONSTRUCTION OF [L9003] ROCKS AND CONCRETE WERE POURED UP AGAINST [W9040]. FLOOR [9024] REACHES [W9040]. BELOW FLOOR 9024 W9040 EXTENDS FOR 2 COURSES INTO

[L9031] AND THEN FLOATS ON THE SANDY FILL MATERIAL OF THAT LOCUS. IT FLO?

IS '02: a) Apparently, the W wall of the pedestal was found in Ak 33, where the same pedestal is called W9345.
