OPENED TO INVESTIGATE RUBBLE MASS [L9048]

DEFINITION/LIMITS [L9080] is the removal of rubble and the definition of stones on the west and north faces of [L9048] revealing [W9090].

It extends north from the pedestal supporting L9000 approx 180cm. It extends west from east bank 1.25cm. It is bounded by the soil of [L9049] on the north and west and [L9059] below [L9049] on the west.

It is limited on the south by the pedestal supporting [L9000]

It is limited on the east by [W9090]

Closing [W9090] defined and pedestal of earth supporting it trimmed.

Relations The soil of [L9049] and [L9059] reached [L9080]. The soil of [L9049] is identical to [L9080] to level 14.74-6<sup>5</sup> which is the closing level.

of [W9090] Below this the soil is identical to

[L9122] which is the soil below [W9090] and [L9083]

The soil of [L9059] touched [L9080] at this level. Clearance of rubble extends down to closing level of [L9059] and [L9049]

MATRIX Soil between stones is very soft light brown sandy soil, almost sterile. At northwest corner murex shells found in loose soil between fallen rocks. At level 14.74 below stones of [W9090] soil changes to hard clay with lenses of ash and charcoal with some pottery, and no stones. This is identical to [L9122]
