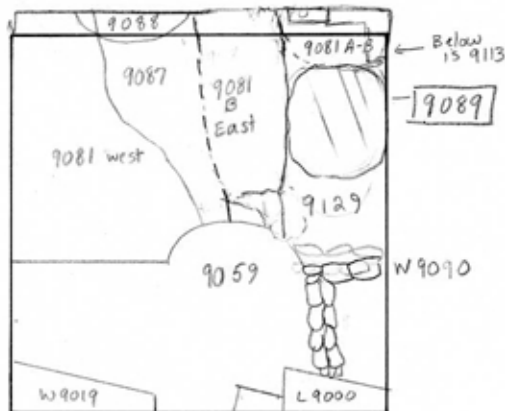

Description: OPENED Discovered deposit of pottery in soft soil while defining surface of L9081

DEFINITIONS L9089 is a pit, of Persian date, approx. 140 cm NS 65 cm EW. It is bounded by L9081 A+B to the north, L9129 to the south. It runs to the eastern bank. It is limited on the west by L9081 B East.

CLOSING Limits of pit reached. Hard brown soil encountered.

Relations L9089 cuts southern part of portion of surface L9081 B in north east

L9089 definitely cuts L9129 which is brown mudbrick materials. It may be continuation of Persian pit L9049 above.
