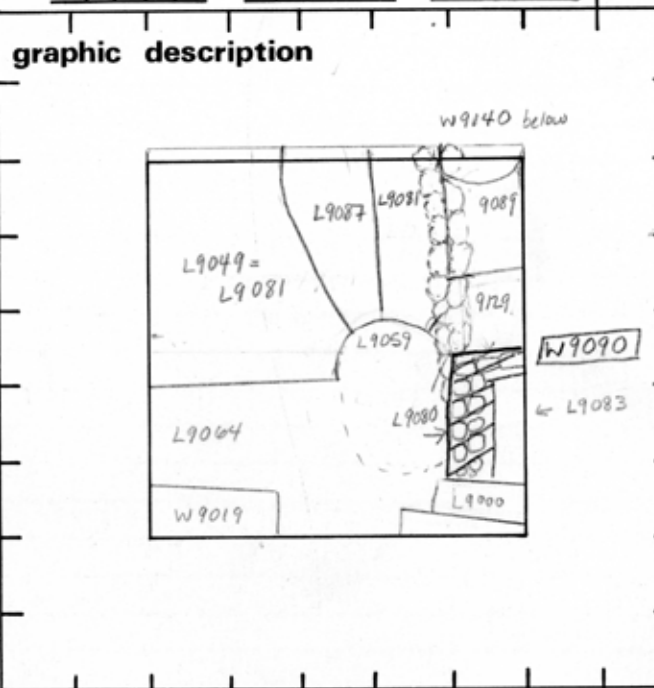

Summary:

Description: OPENED W9090 was opened when cleaning of rubble mass L9048 revealed wall.

DEF/LIM W9090 is an L Shaped wall of rough and roughly shaped stones. It extends west from the Eastern baulk approx 1.10 cm. It extends north from the pedestal supporting L9000 approx 1.80 cm. It is 3 courses deep and 2 rows wide N-S. It is 3 courses deep and one row wide E-W. It is bounded on the east by L9083 and on the ^{north} west by L9080 which was wall cleaning. It was originally bounded by the soil of L9049 last year.

CLOSING wall defined. Removed to excavate L9122 below

RELATIONS The soil of L9049 reached W9090 on the west and north. The soil and rubble of L9083 reach W9090 on the east and south, and

perhaps from a packing or platform within W9090. W9090 does not appear to continue into the pedestal supporting L9000, but abuts a "wall" of stones visible in the baulk of the pedestal. W9090 lay directly upon a grey lense of ash approx 10cm thick which is considered to be a surface which extended below L9083 to the east baulk and pedestal of L9000. This surface sloped down from W to E. No thickness of the grey ash was noted below L9083.
