L9229 IS A MIXTURE OF TOPSOIL FILL THAT SHOWS NO SIGNS OF HAVING BEEN "CUT" BY W9096, THOUGH UNDOUBTEDLY SOME OF THIS MIXED MATERIAL WAS "CUT" WHEN THE WALL WAS BUILT. Originally W9096 cut fill to either side but it is felt that this earlier fill can not be distinguished from the topsoil.

REASON FOR CLOSING: END OF SEASON, NOT CLOSED.

RELATIONS: COVERED BY [L9361] AND REACHED BY [L9381], BOTH TOPSOILS; IT PROBABLY CUTS THE ROBBEY TRENCH [L9404] AND [L9424]. AT END OF SEASON THE BOTTOM OF THE WALL HAD NOT BEEN REACHED. IT IS THE EASTERN EXTENSION OF A WALL FIRST DISCOVERED IN SQUARE A132.

New Relations: W9096 CUTS W9839 AND W9840. W9839 IS THE EASTERN CORNER TO W9278 AND W9840 IS A WESTERN CORNER TO W9278, WHICH WAS FOUND IN THE WEST BALK. W9278, W9839, AND W9840 ARE ALL PERSIAN PERIOD WALLS. W9096 ALSO CUTS W9425, WHICH EXTENDS NORTH TO SOUTH ALONG THE EAST BALK. W9425 IS OF THE SAME PERSIAN CONSTRUCTION PHASE AS W9839, W9840, AND W9278. RATHER THAN SIMPLY CUTTING W9839, W9840, AND W9425, W9096 MAY HAVE BEEN POURED OVER THESE LOGS AND COVER THEM. W9096 APPEARS TO CUT L9773. THE BOTTOM OF THE LOWEST COURSE HAS NOT YET BEEN FOUND AND SO W9096 DOES NOT FLOAT ABOVE L9773.

Note: IN THE PHOTO, W9096 IS AT THE VERY BACK OF THE PHOTO

Additional Observations/Value: STILL A ROMAN WALL AND STILL VERY VALUABLE. If you like Roman cement walls.
