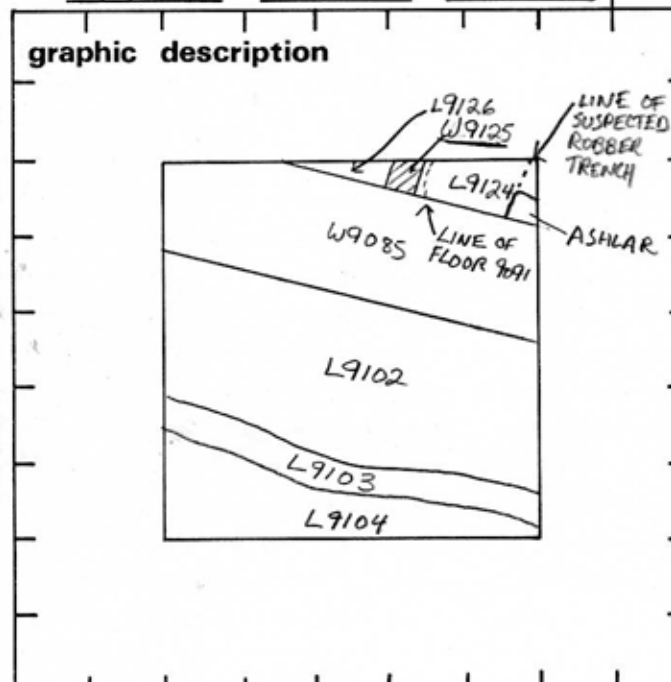

WHICH REACHES W9085 COULD POSSIBLY HAVE REACHED W9125 BUT IT IS UNLIKELY THAT THEY WERE CONTEMPORARY BECAUSE F9091 MOST CERTAINLY REPRESENTS A LEVEL OF SUB-FLOORING FOR THE ORIGINAL FLOOR OF 9085 WHICH WAS CUT STONE. ONLY ONE STONE SURVIVES FROM THIS ORIGINAL FLOOR (N AT 34).
