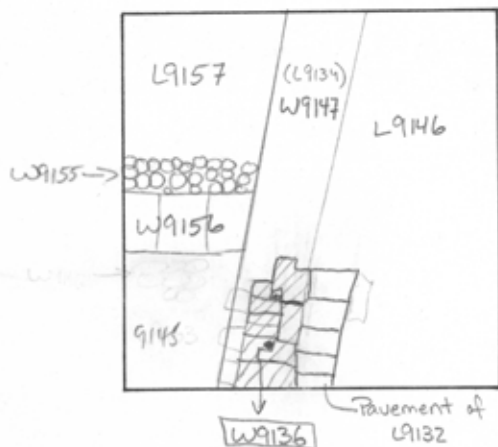

OPENED: L9132 CAME DOWN UPON A WALL W9136.
 DEFINITION/LIMITS: L9136 IS DIRECTLY UNDER ^{diff-not pavement} L9132 AND DIRECTLY ABOVE W9147. TO THE NORTH LAY LOCUS L9134 WHICH LAY ON TOP OF W9147, TO THE SOUTH IS THE SOUTHERN BULK, TO THE EAST LAY L9145 AND BELOW THAT L9162 AND L9163. TO THE EAST, ABUTTING W9136 ARE PAVEMENT STONES (FLOOR OF L9132).

MATRIX: LIMESTONE BLOCKS, ONE COURSE DEEP, CUT ASHLARS.

REASON FOR CLOSING: END OF SEASON

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: W9136 IS DIRECTLY UNDER L9132. IT CONSISTS OF ONE COARSE LAID, ON TOP OF ^{DIRECTLY} WALL W9147. WITHIN W9136, A THRESHOLD WAS BUILT. THE THRESHOLD FACES EAST, AND DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF THE THRESHOLD IS A LAYER OF PAVEMENT STONES (FLOOR OF L9132). TO THE WEST W9136 IS REACHED BY L9145, TO THE NORTH WAS PATCHY MUDBRICK MATERIAL L9134
