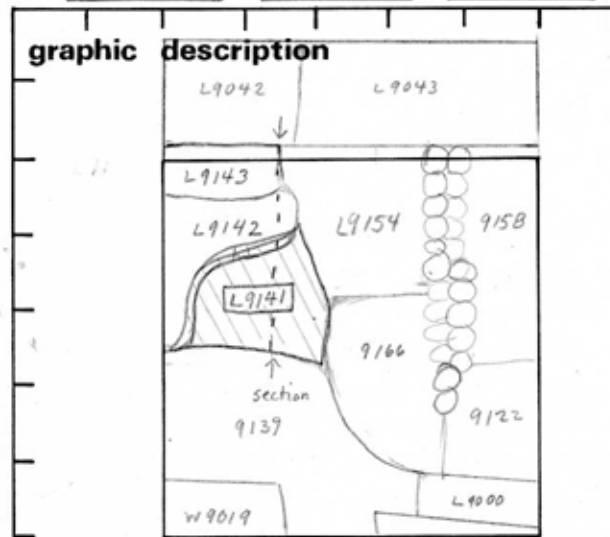

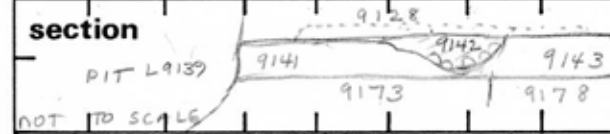

Summary:

Description: OPENING [L9141] was opened when an accumulation of dark ash [L9142] bounded by lighter material [L9141] and [L9142] were defined below [L9128]. Also to remove Southern surface of [L9128]

DEF/LIM [L9141] is an accumulation of soil south of the dark ash pit [L9142]. [L9141] is bounded on the north and west by [L9142]. It is limited on the east by [L9166] and [L9154]. [L9141] is limited by [L9139] on the south.

Closing [Soil change to reddish brown clayey soil identical to that below [L9142]. Loci collapse into [L9173].



Relations [L9141] is cut by Persian pit [L9139] and partially cut by it. It was possibly cut by [L9142] which partially overlies

it in the north. It reaches the mudbrick material of [L9166] and the red clayey soil of [L9154] which it also overlies? Maybe refuse assoc. with use of [L9142]

Matrix [L9141] is compact grey brown soil mixed with grey ash similar to [L9143] but more clayey. Many rocks about 10cm dia found throughout similar to those found in [L9142]
