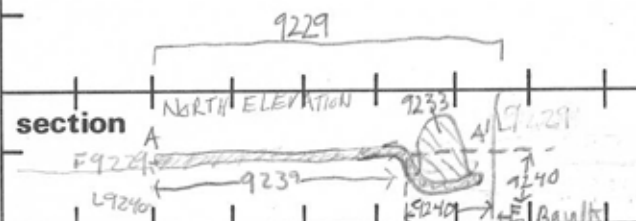
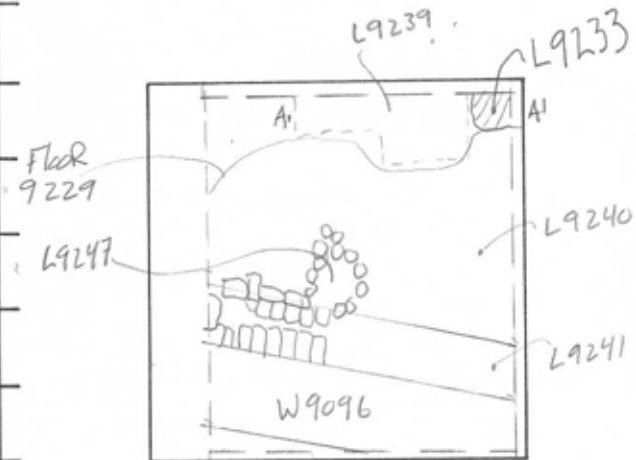

Description: REASON FOR OPENING: CAME UPON SHELL DEPOSIT WHILE CLEARING FLOOR [9229].

DEFINITION/LIMITS: SHELL MOUND IN N.E. CORNER OF SQUARE EXTENDS W 40 CM WEST AND 450 CM SOUTH.

MATRIX: CLAM SHELLS, GREASY, SANDY SOIL

FINDS: PERSIAN FIGURE AND 1/2 BRONZE BRACELET.

REASON FOR CLOSING: REACHED FLOOR [9229]

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: RESTS ON FLOOR [9229]. REACHED IN SOUTH BY [L9229] AND [L9240] SUCCESSIVELY. REACHED IN WEST BY [L9229]. DISAPPEARS INTO NORTH AND EAST Baulks.

THE DEPOSIT WAS OPENED JUST BEFORE THE FLOOR WAS FOUND THE FLOOR IT SITS ON DIPPED BELOW THE AVERAGE FLOOR LEVEL, AND WAS NOT FOUND UNTIL AFTER LOCUS

[L9240] WAS OPENED AT A HIGHER LEVEL THAN THIS SECTION OF FLOOR, CONSEQUENTLY, THIS DEPOSIT SITS ON FLOOR [9229], BUT "CUTS" [L9240]
