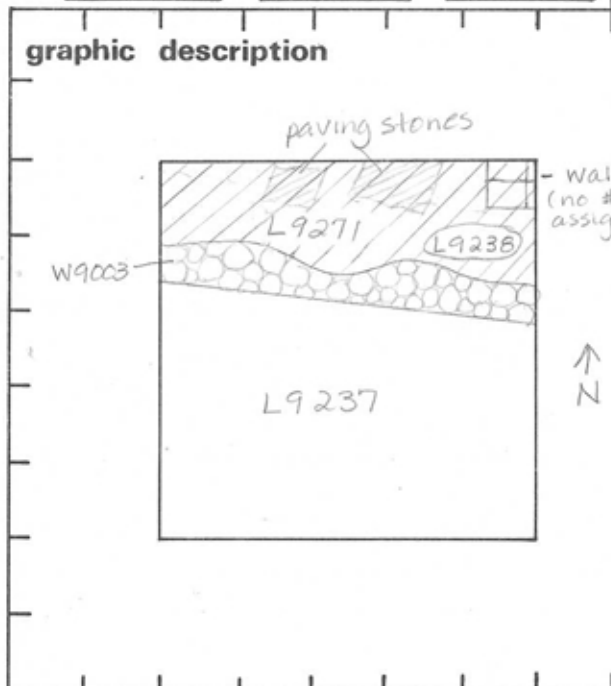

Summary:

Description: Opened: W9003 split Square AK33 into 2 loci: L9237 & L9238. L9238 continues excavation of Square AK33 in the area North of W9003

Matrix: Light brown soil containing occasional fragments of roofing tile & tesserae. Numerous stones, probably loose stones of W9003 were present in the soil of L9238.

Definition/Limits: L9238 includes the area North of W9003 (which lies in an approximate E-W line across Square AK.33) & extends to the N bank.

Reason for Closing: L9238 was closed upon the discovery of 3 stones which form the corner of a wall (not yet assigned a locus number) in the extreme NE corner of Square AK33.

the topsoil locus L9220, and directly N of W9003. The 3 corner stones of a wall lie under L9238 in the NE corner. L9271 underlies L9238. W9003 cuts L9237 & L9238.

Note: L9238 includes 2 large floating paving (?) stones, the source of which is uncertain.
