Summary:

Description:

Opened: Excavation revealed header wall [9243] which split [L9237] into [W9243], [L9242] & [L9244].

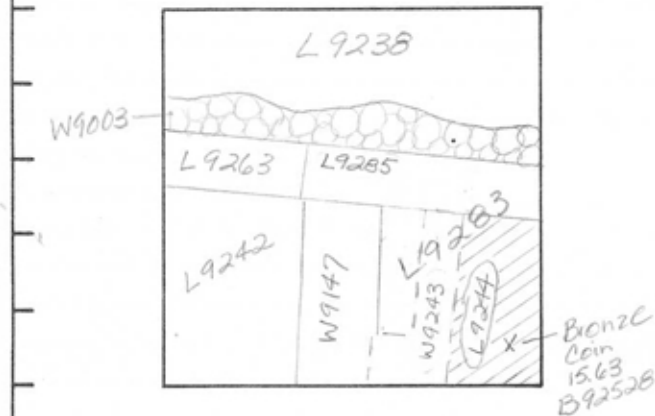
Matrix: Medium brown soil containing clumps of kurkar, many stones & few fragments of tesserae and roofing tiles (similar to matrices of [L9238] & [L9271]).

Definition/Limits: [L9244] is bounded to the S & E by the baulks; to the N, by the paving stones of [L9237], & to the W, by the header wall [9243].

Reason for closing: Removal of header wall [9243], & of material ([L9285]) beneath paving stones of [L9237] revealed soil identical to that of [L9244]. Loci [9285] & [9244] and the

material immediately below [W9243] were combined into [L9283].

Relation to Other Elements: [W9243] cuts [L9244]. [L9244] reaches [L9285] and the material below [W9243]. Is or: L's RT (of W9150) probably extends through this locus.
