

FIVE COURSES <sup>OF [W9253]</sup> ARE ABOVE THE ELEVATION OF F9231; THE SIXTH COURSE AS WELL AS TWO ASHLARS FROM THE FIFTH COURSE <sup>OR [W9253]</sup> ARE BELOW THE ELEVATION OF F9231.
