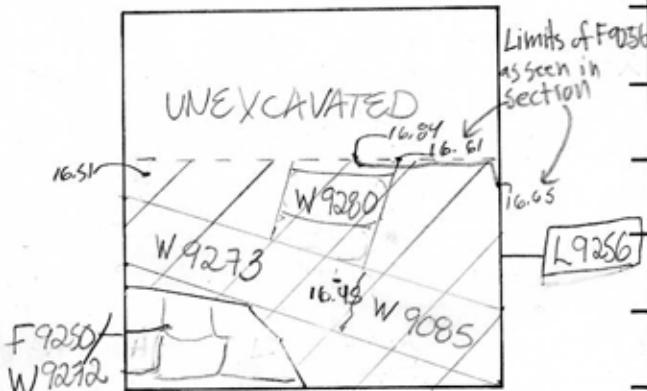

DEFINITION AND LIMITS: EXTENDS FROM SOUTH BULK AND FLOOR 9250 ON SOUTH SIDE TO THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF EXCAVATIONS (IN THIS SQUARE) 3M.

MATRIX: LIGHT SANDY SOIL CONTAINING MUCH PLASTER AND SHELL PROBABLY UNTRACEABLE REMAINS OF A FLOOR SOME SCATTERED KURKAR. PLASTER REMAINS SHOW UP IN N & S BULKS. THIS LINE EXTENDS 3.05 M FROM THE NE CORNER ALONG THE N BULK AND 1.14 M ALONG THE EAST BULK. THE HIGHEST SIGNS OF PLASTER RUBBLE ARE AT AN ELEVATION OF 16.82 M THE POWDERY PLASTER FLOOR MATERIAL APPEARS IN SPOTTY PATCHES BEGINNING AT AN ELEVATION OF 16.65 M. DOWNWARDS IS 20 CM.
