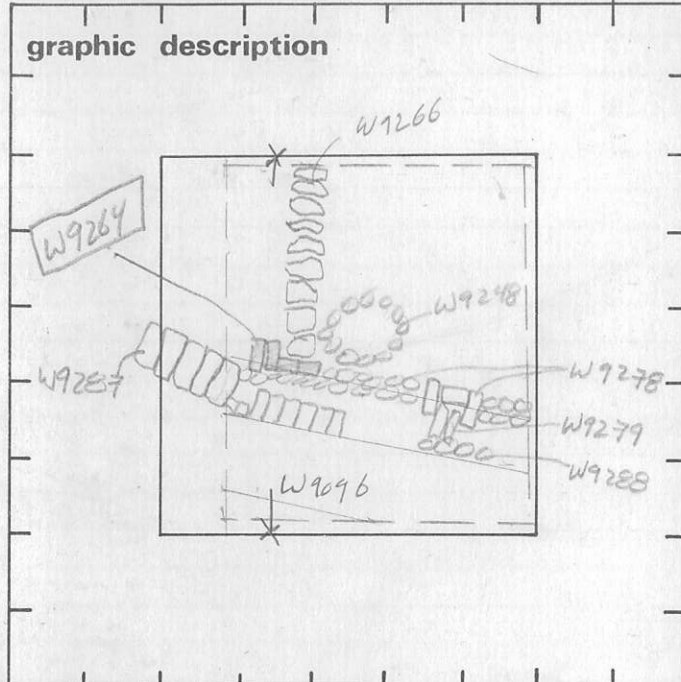
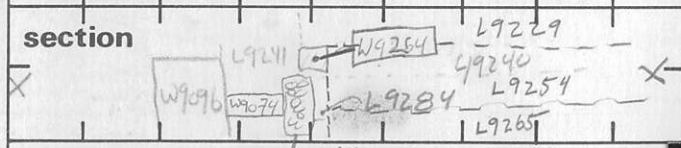

 MATRIX: SANDSTONE ASHLARS ~LENGTH 90cm, WIDTH 25cm, HEIGHT 15cm
 REASON FOR CLOSING: WALL REMOVED TO EXCAVATE [L9289] BELOW WALL
 RELATIONS TO OTHER ELEMENTS: FLOATS ABOVE** AND PARALLEL TO [W9278]. DOES NOT REACH [W9248]. [L9240] COVERS W9264. TRENCH [L9247] REACHES (BUT DOES NOT ROB?) W9264. [L9289] IS SEALED DIRECTLY BELOW WALL - WALL CUT [L9264]
