Summary:

**Description:** Reason for opening: Came down on [W9147], which divided [L9242]. At same elevation, the material of [L9263] was cleared. The soils below [L9263], & below [L9242] were determined to be identical, and the loci were combined to form [L9270].

**Definition/Limits:** [L9270] is bounded to the N by [W9003], to the E by [W9147], & to the S & W by the banks.

**Reason for Closing:** Not closed - End of Season

**Relation to Other Elements:** [L9270] is cut by [W9003] & by [W9147]. The loci immediately above are [L9263] & [L9242].

**Matrix:** Light brown sandy soil, very fine & loose, & containing much pottery. [L9283] consists of

light brown soil, densely packed, & containing numerous chunks of rock. The matrix of [L9148] in Square AK32 is very similar to that of [L9270], except that [L9270] contained much pottery, whereas [L9148] contained very little.
