Opened: To remove L9300 pavement and excavate below

Closed: L9300 removed, opened L18012 and L18013. L18012 is a "phantom" floor directly underneath L9300 pavement, and L18013 is the fill under L9300 to the lower matrix: floor F18012.

matrix: See previous seasons cards. In between the pavement stones, the fill was deemed to be disturbed due to growth of weeds and several seasons worth of exposure. However - the pavement L9300 seals all loci below.

Relations: Pavement L9300 covers and seals L18012 (phantom floor patches traced at various points immediately below L9300, see plan) and L18013. The floor patches below L9300 were given phantom #L18012 because it was deemed confusing to give a floor number to pavement L9300. L18013 was opened when it was thought F18012 was defined, but excavation in L18013 turned up more of F18012. Thus both L9300 and L18013 come down on F18012 (see plan + section).

L9300 also seals L18026, L18035, and installation L18036 as these are only slightly below F18012 and L18013. L18026 is the floor makeup of F18012 and the fill below to L18035 and L18036. F18035 was a smaller stone pavement found below L9300.

The stones in F18035 are not as large as those in F9300. F9300 and F18035 are the only stone floors found in Iron Age Area G. L9300 also covers and seals possible wall W18048.

For relations with surrounding loci see L9300 cards from earlier seasons

Additional Observations/Value: L9300 has high value, as it seals an almost identical stone pavement F18035 below. Both F9300 and F18035 are the only stone floors found in Iron Age Area G.

Sketch plan 1:100

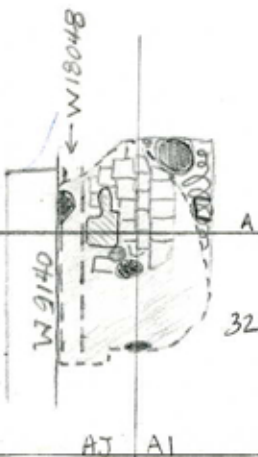

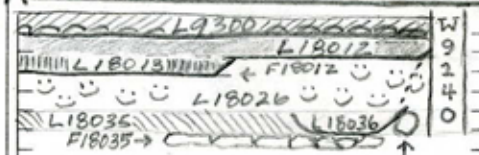
