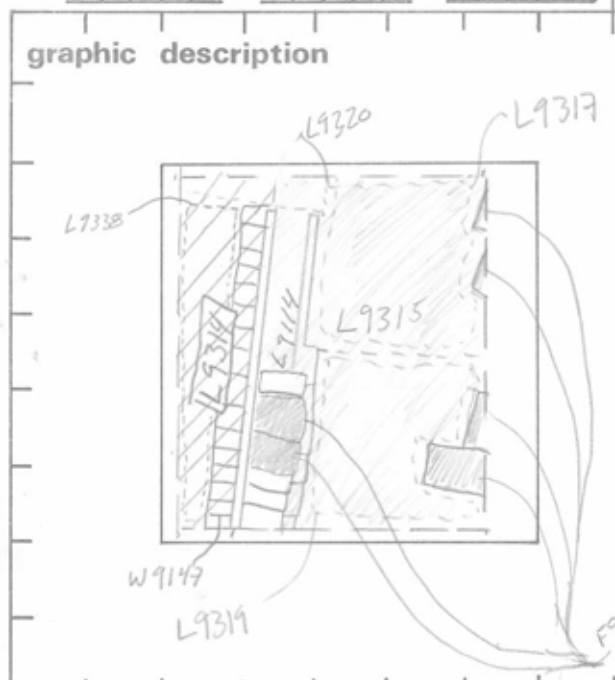

 DEFINITION/LIMITS: REACHES SOUTH, WEST AND NORTH  
 BOUNDARIES: BORDERED ON EAST BY WEST WALL LINE OF DRAIN L9114  
 MATRIX: DARK TOPSOIL MATERIAL CONTAINING LITTLE  
 POTTERY; NO TESSERAE OR ROSETTES WERE FOUND.  
 REASON FOR CLOSING: CAME DOWN ON W9147  
 RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: REACHES L9114. IS ABOVE  
W9147 AND L9338 AND L9320 (THE ROBBER TRENCH).  
 LOCUS IS MIXED TOPSOIL MATERIAL WHICH SHOWS NO SIGN  
 OF BEING "CUT" BY L9114, BUT THIS MATERIAL IS PROBABLY  
 A MIX OF THE CUT MATERIAL AND TOPSOIL. L9114 WAS CUT INTO  
 A FILL BUT AT THIS TIME IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO DETERMINE A BORDER  
 BETWEEN THE "CUT" FILL AND THE "UNCUT" TOPSOIL. JZ '89
