 [L9114] WHICH SPLIT L9307 INTO [L9314] AND [L9315]  
 DEFINITION/LIMITS: REACHES [L9114] ON WESTERN SIDE.  
 EXTENDS FROM [L9114] EAST TO: NORTH, SOUTH AND  
 EAST BAULKS.  
 MATRIX: DARK SOIL THE SAME AS IN LOCUS ABOVE  
 [L9307]. DARK SOIL CONTAINING MANY POTTERY FRAGMENTS  
 TESSERAE AND FEW ROOF TILE.  
 REASON FOR CLOSING: CAME TO SOIL CHANGE. SOIL  
 UNDER NORTH SIDE OF [L9315] CONTAINS MANY SHELLS,  
 SCATTERED KURAR AND IS SANDY. THIS IS [L9317].  
 SOIL UNDER SOUTH SIDE OF [L9315] IS A LIGHTER  
 BROWN BUT STILL SEEMS MUCH LIKE [L9319] THIS IS  
 [L9319].

 [L9114] AND IS ABOVE [L9317] AND [L9319].  
 [L9315] IS TOPSOIL WHICH PROBABLY FILLED  
 THE AREA AFTER PAVING STONES [L9000],  
 WHICH APPEAR IN BAULK WERE ROBBED  
 OUT. [L9315] COVERS THE EAST WALL OF DRAIN [L9114].  
 THIS [L9315] IS LATER THAN [L9114].
