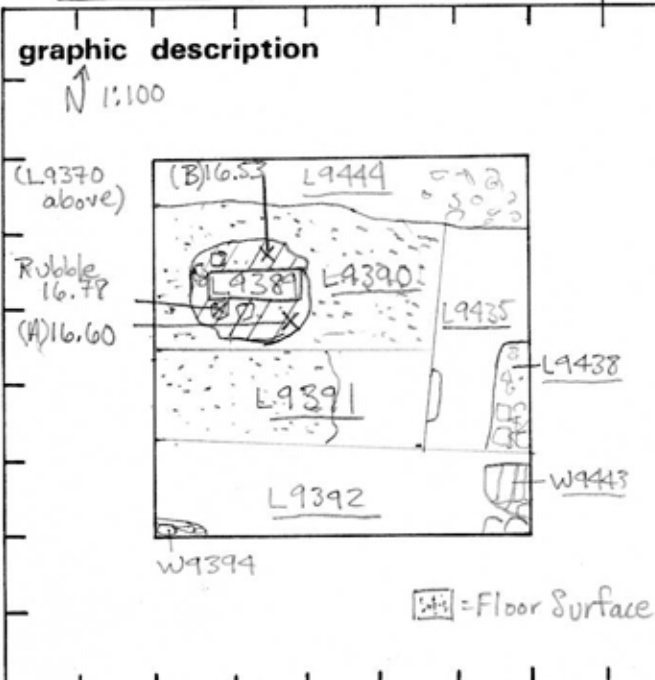

**MATRIX:** CHUNKS OF MARBLE & SANDSTONE RESTING ON SURFACE A (CRUSHED KURKAR), BELOW WHICH IS SURFACE B (CRUSHED POTTERY)

KURKAR SURFACE WHICH MAY POSSIBLY BE THE SAME SURFACE AS THE ONE IN [L9371]. SOIL BETWEEN SURFACE A & B WAS STERILE SO LOCUS NUMBER NOT CHANGED. SURFACE B (CRUSHED POTTERY) IS IDENTICAL IN MAKEUP AND AT APPROXIMATELY THE SAME LEVEL AS THE FLOOR IN [L9391]. IT IS ONE OF THE RESURFACINGS OF THE FLOORS THAT COVERED THE HYPOTHESIZED ROOM. THE RUBBLE (STONES & MARBLE) MIGHT HAVE BEEN PART OF THE ROOMS WALLS WHICH WERE ROBBED OUT.
