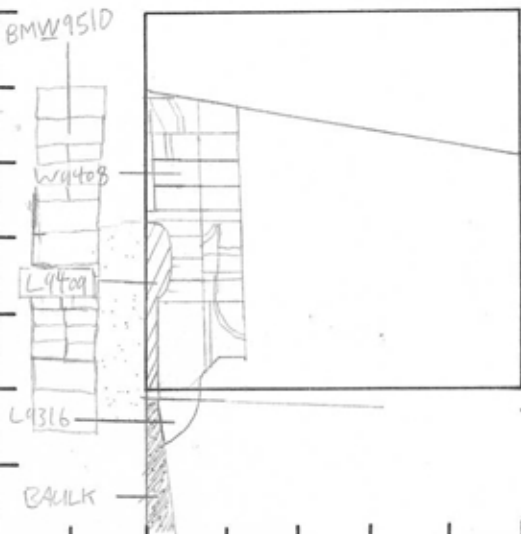


TEL DOR 1989 field G square AJ3.4 phase (in area): LOCUS 49.40.9

Summary:

Description: Reason for opening: L9181 (a pit) began bottoming out and was split into L9409, the continuation of L9181 and W9408, the masonry wall it cuts.

Definition/Limits: defined by W9408 to the North and East, and by the material below L9316 to the South.

Matrix: loose, grey, ashy soil w/ few sherds.

Reason For Closing: not closed, end of '89 season.

Relationship to Other Elements: L9409 cuts W9408. L9409 is covered by L9181, of which it is the continuation. It reaches the lower level of L9316, of

which it is also the continuation. L9316 and L9181 cut the upper courses of W9408. L9181, of which L9409 is the continuation, extends into SQ AK34 and seems to go under BM W9510, the pier and ashlar wall.

L9409 not actually excavated in 1989, only identified.
